

Funding for Time to Shine in Leeds is from the Ageing Better Programme. **Leeds Older People's Forum (LOPF)** manages Time to Shine (TTS). The focus is on **reducing social isolation and loneliness in people aged 50+**. Funding ends in March 2021.

14 Ageing Better programmes across England are funded by **The National Lottery Community Fund**. Ageing Better is focused on research, learning and evidence.

The **Time to Shine Core Partnership** leads, supports and gives strategic direction to the Time to Shine programme. Core Partnership members are a diverse mix of third, public and private sector organisations in Leeds and individual older people.

Leeds Community Foundation is commissioned by Time to Shine to manage all Small Funds contracts.

The **Time to Shine programme team** are all employed by Leeds Older People's Forum. Two **programme managers** are responsible for all TTS project contracts (including the contract with Leeds Community Foundation). One programme manager is focused on legacy, the other on learning.
