

Who are Enhance?

The Enhance Programme brings together a partnership of 14 third sector delivery partners and health and social care professionals across Leeds to provide person-centred holistic support at home for people who have either been discharged after a hospital stay or are trying to avoid a hospital admission.

Why refer to Enhance? Better to ask why not!

If a person is living alone with little or no support from family and friends, Enhance can help to make sure the person is safe, warm, has food, social contact, is linked to other services and is accessing benefits etc. Working together Enhance will save you time, reduce your concerns for the individual and support the person in their recovery.

What do Enhance Third Sector Delivery Partners do?



Person-centred support

- Home visits
- Opportunities for social connection
- Support for setting up services to manage health (repeat prescriptions, dosette boxes, key safes etc)



Information and advice

- Ensure home environment is safe including; a safe and well referral to Fire service and welfare benefits check
- Prompting exercise
- Support self-management
- Provision of regular contact/check-in for up to three months
- Support access to health appointments
- Ensure access to food



Partnership work

- Joint visits when needed
- Regular communication - appropriate information sharing
- Agency advocacy, liaison and referrals
